The JICA assisted Project for Improvement of Himachal Pradesh Forest Ecosystems Management & Livelihoods (PIHPFEM&L) was initially implemented in 18 Forest Divisions of 7 Forest Circles. Now w.e.f. - To facilitate the execution of the Project activities by VFDS (PFM Mode), its monitoring and evaluation.
- To facilitate the formation of SHGs/CIGs.
- To facilitate the Capacity Development of the Stakeholders.
- To facilitate inter sectoral convergence at district level.
- Monitoring of the field activities as per requirement of Project Director (M&E), Kullu.
- Any other assignment given by Chief Project Director pertaining to the Project.

These Retired HPFS Officers will be paid fixed emoluments @ Rs. 50,000/- per month, out of the Project Funds. Initially the engagement would be for a period of one year and can be extended further if required by the Project.

Their posting/placement will be decided by the Chief Project Director (JICA assisted PIHPFEM&L). The Headquarters of the Retired HPFS will be at the O/o DFOs concerned or if engaged for more than one division, in that case O/o one of the Division as per the convenience of the retired HPFS Officers.

The Chief Project Director (JICA assisted PIHPFEM&L) is authorized to discontinue the services of any of the so engaged Retired HPFS Officers, if their performance is not found satisfactory without any notice/assigning any reason.
