  - In term loans, the repayment must be made as per the repayment schedule in the banks.

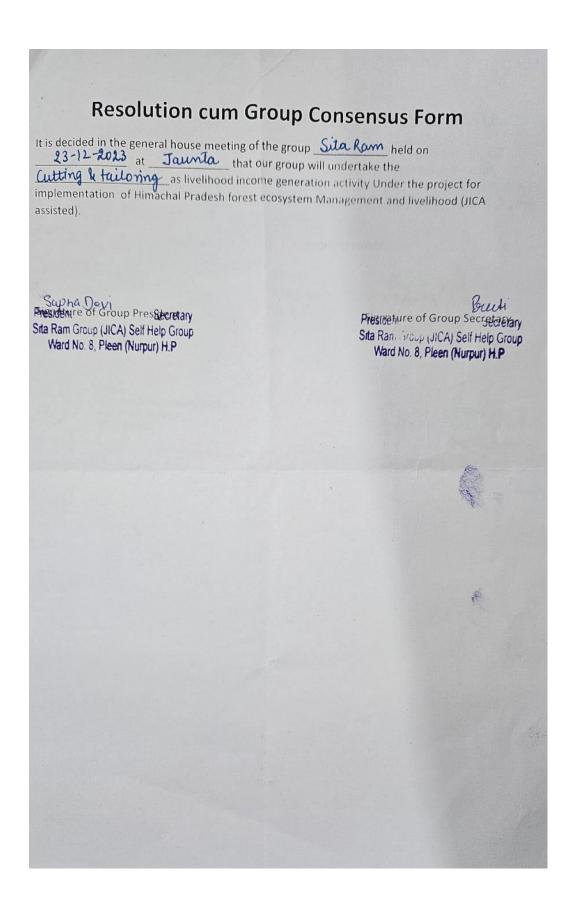
#### 15. Monitoring Method -
