

## **NOTICE INVITING APPLICATIONS**

**Subject: Engaging Retired HPFS Officers/Range Officers in JICA assisted Project for Improvement of Himachal Pradesh Forest Ecosystems Management & Livelihoods (PIHPFEM&L).**

The JICA assisted Project for Improvement of Himachal Pradesh Forest Ecosystems Management & Livelihoods (PIHPFEM&L) is being implemented in 18 Forest Divisions of 7 Forest Circles falling in six districts (i.e. Kinnaur/Shimla/Bilaspur/Mandi/Kullu & Lahaul Spiti) of the State. The initial two years' Preparatory phase of the Project is over and the Implementation phase has started from this financial year 2020-21. In the Implementation Phase a number of important activities of the Project including nursery improvement, seedling production, advance works, Plantations, Soil Moisture Conservation works, Microplans preparation, Biodiversity conservation works, capacity building & trainings, monitoring etc are to be carried on priority at an accelerated pace.

Accordingly, services of Eight (8) Retired HPFS Officers/ Range Officers purely in accordance with the instructions/rules of the Finance department regarding reemployment of the retired Government Servants will be hired.

### **The key responsibilities of engaged retired HPFS/ROs would be:-**

- To facilitate DFOs in technical and administrative matters of the Project at division level.
- To facilitate in getting the VFDS/BMC subcommittee formed & registered and Microplans prepared through consultations with the communities.
- To facilitate Annual plan preparation.
- To coordinate with the Project Ranges (FTUs), SMS and FTU Co-ordinators vis-a vis DMU.
- To facilitate the execution of the Project activities by VFDS (PFM Mode), it's monitoring and evaluation
- To facilitate the formation of SHGs/CIGs
- To facilitate the Capacity Development of the Stakeholders.
- To facilitate inter sectoral convergence at district level.
- Any other assignment given by CPD pertaining to the Project.

The emoluments will be purely in accordance with the office memorandum No Fin(C) –B (7)-13/2009 dated 23.03.2017 of the Finance department. The engagement would be for a period of one year initially subject to extension if required by the Project.

Their posting/placement will be decided by the Chief Project Director (JICA assisted PIHPFEM&L). The Headquarters of the Retired HPFS/ROS will be at the O/o DFOs concerned or if engaged for more than one division, in that case O/o one of the Division as per the convenience of the retired employee.

The Chief Project Director (JICA assisted PIHPFEM&L) is authorized to discontinue with the services of any of the so engaged Retired HPFS/Range Officers, if their performance is not found satisfactory without any notice/assigning any reason.


