## 2. Instructions to Bidders

### 2.1 General Instructions

- 2.1.1 The organization (bidder) shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its proposal and PIHPFEM&L will in no case be responsible or liable for these costs, whether the proposal is finally accepted or not.
- 2.1.2 Proposal validity shall be for 120 days.
- 2.1.3 The organization (bidder) should submit their Bid Proposal, with supporting documents in the prescribed formats only. - 2.1.13 All offers should be made in English. Conditional offers, and offers qualified by such vague and indefinite expression such as "Subject to immediate acceptance" etc. will not be considered.

- 2.2.1 The project areas (High altitude villages nearer to the natural habitat of the species tentatively in villages Chhain Maigal, Ruhal and Bukhras under Gohar Block, Tehsil Chachiot, Distt. Mandi, Himachal Pradesh) are situated in tough hilly/ mountainous terrain. Bidders are requested to get them acquainted with general topography/ terrain conditions of the project area, meticulously go through the scope/ deliverables and correctly assess the project requirements while submitting their offer.
- 2.2.2 The bidding firm would be required to submit, in detail, the approach proposed to be adopted by the firm to manage the entire series of activities which begin with the community orientation, organization, training for cultivation, harvesting and marketing of *Picrorhiza kurrooa* (Kutki).

#### Stage 1:

Technical evaluation, based on past experiences and technical expertise, shall be carried out for eligible bidders by assigning Technical Scores as specified below:

### Stage-2

Financial Proposals shall be evaluated only of those bidders who score at least 60 marks out of 100 in Technical Proposal evaluation. The lowest evaluated Financial Proposal will be given the maximum financial score of 100 points. The financial scores  $(F_n)$  of the other technically qualified Financial Proposals will be computed as per the formula given below:

# 6. Terms of Reference (TOR)

## 1. Background and Context

Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) assisted "Project for Improvement of Himachal Pradesh Forest Ecosystems Management and Livelihoods" (PIHPFEM&L) aims at contributing to eco-restoration and development of forest resources through sustainable forest ecosystem management, biodiversity conservation, livelihood improvement support for the target community and institutional capacity strengthening. The selected project areas include high altitude villages namely Chhain Maigal, Ruhal and Bukhras under Gohar Block, Tehsil Chachiot, District Mandi, Himachal Pradesh.

### 2. Specific Details

Mountain communities living in the Himalayas are heavily dependent upon natural resources. Extraction of plants from nature offer age-old vocation to the people living in close proximity with nature to meet health and economic demand. Unplanned collection and marketing of medicinal plants from the wild in the Indian Himalayan Region (IHR) has threatened their diversity and livelihoods of rural people alike. *Picrorhiza kurrooa* is a well-known herb in the Ayurvedic system of medicine which has traditionally been used to treat disorders of liver and upper respiratory tract, fever, dyspepsia, chronic diarrhea, and scorpion sting. It is a small perennial herb from the Scrophulariaceae family found in the Himalayan region at elevations of 2500-3500 meters. It has a long, creeping rootstock which is bitter in taste and grows in rock crevices and moist, sandy soil. The active constituents are obtained from stolon. Although the plant is self-regenerating but unregulated over-harvesting has caused it to be threatened to near extinction.

Keeping in view these facts, Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) assisted "Project for Improvement of Himachal Pradesh Forest Ecosystems Management and Livelihoods" (PIHPFEM&L) intends to carry out a project on the Cultivation of *Picrorhiza kurrooa* (Kutki) in organized community cluster for livelihood and commercial production.

### 3. Objectives

The objectives of the assignment are:

- a) Execution of project in the high altitude areas in District Mandi and propose realistic work norms (for materials and labours) for nursery/planting operations for *ex-situ* cultivation of *P. kurrooa* and
- b) Manage the complete "value chain", the entire series of activities which begin with community orientation, organization, training for cultivation, harvesting and marketing of this species

### 4. Scope of Work

To achieve the above-mentioned objectives, following tasks are envisaged to be undertaken in this regard:

- The agency needs to initiate *ex-situ* cultivation of *P. kurrooa* in 1.5 hectare area of the high altitude villages namely Chhain Maigal, Ruhal, Bukhras under Gohar Block, Tehsil Chachiot of Mandi District above 2500 meter altitudes in the first go.
- Selection of 1.5 hectare area for cultivation of *P. kurrooa* in the identified villages.
- Adequate planting material of *P. kurrooa* needs to be arranged/year by the agency from existing nurseries of farmers and Research Institutions.
- Identification of target groups (at least 50 farmers) and their training on cultivation and harvesting techniques.
- Hand holding and regular technical support to the project field workers to establish the cultivation plots.
- Establish market linkages so that the concerned farmers are able to sustain themselves once the project activities are over.
